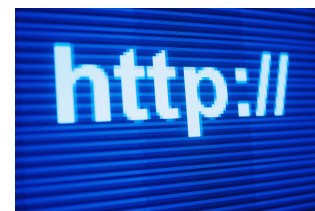

Hints and Tips for Students



Search Intelligently

- Think carefully about your key words.
- Use 'Advanced Search' to focus your search.

Be Selective

- Use a minimum of two *reliable* sources.
- Find sources at the right level (not too advanced or too simple).
- Think about the reliability of your sources – author, site, motives, bias, checkable facts.
- Don't rely too much on Wikipedia – anyone can contribute.

Avoid Plagiarism

- Include a bibliography (list of sources).
- Direct quotes in inverted commas.
- Use your own 'voice' (your own words and phrases).
- Include source url under pictures (small font).
