

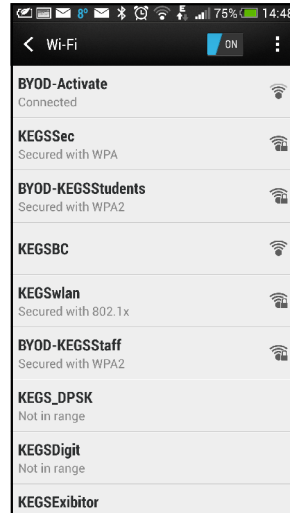
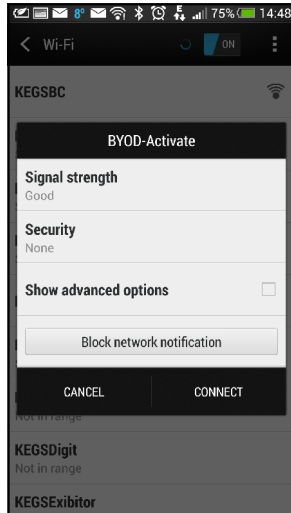
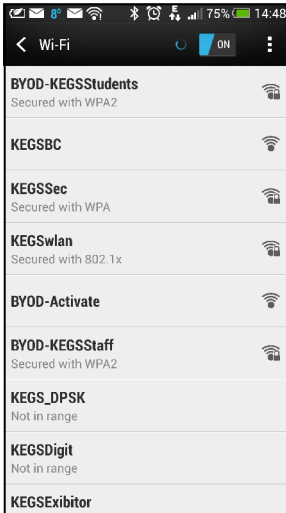


Setting up your Android device for wireless access at school

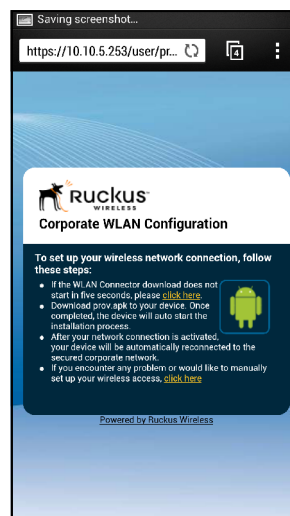
On your Android device, go to Settings - Wi-Fi.

Connect your device to 'BYOD-Activate'.

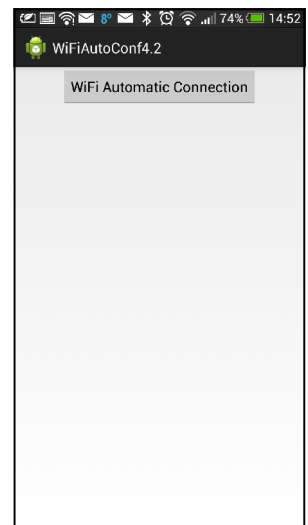
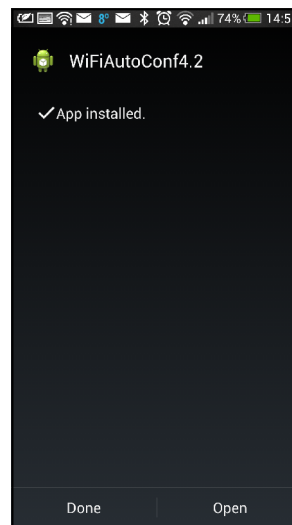
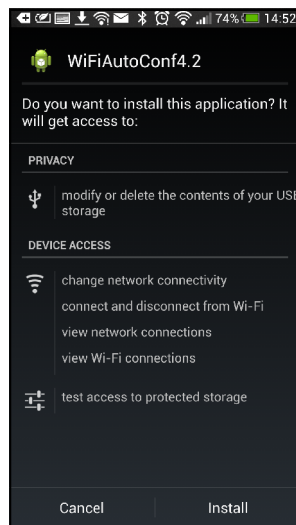
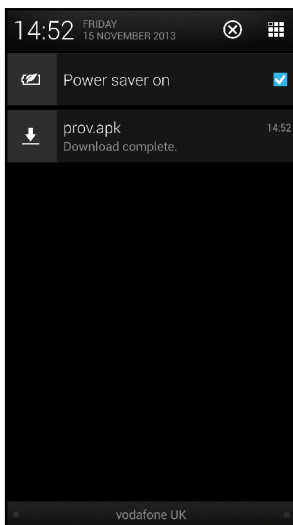


Using your device's native internet browser (not Chrome), navigate to <https://10.10.5.253/activate> and click 'Continue' if you see a security certificate warning.

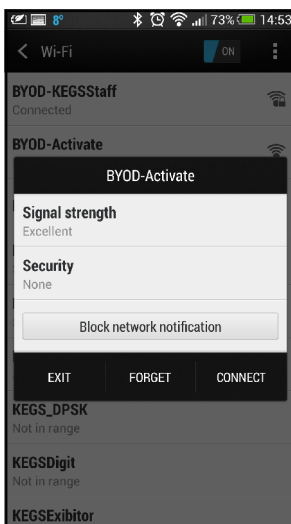
Enter your network username and password (e.g. cwright_staff) at the Ruckus Wifi Connection Activation page and tap Log In. WiFi Automatic Config app will be downloaded.



When the app has downloaded (a small down arrow will appear at the top of the screen), pull the screen down and tap on 'prov.apk'. Tap Install. Tap Open. Tap 'WiFi Automatic Connection'. The wireless settings profile will then be installed.



Go back to the Wi-Fi settings, and 'Forget' BYOD-Activate.



Connect your device to 'BYOD-KEGSStaff' or 'BYOD-KEGSStudents' as appropriate if it is not already connected. You should now be able to browse the internet.
